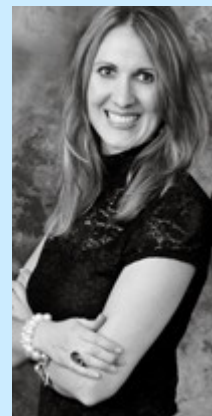
INTRODUCING OUR NEW INTERN
